<u>Season in Review</u>



- Mostly dry year low soil moisture levels
- High bunch number and excellent flowering
- All blocks required crop thinning
- Higher than average tonnages at harvest
- Good disease control, under high pressure conditions
- High quality clean parcels fruit at harvest




Tonnages 2016



- Pinot Noir 42 Tonnes
- Chardonnay 41 Tonnes
- Pinot Gris 49 Tonnes
- Riesling
 113 Tonnes
- Sauvignon 863 Tonnes

This season



- Relatively dry winter with a changeable rainy spring
- Pruning completed to a very high standard
- Fewer than normal frost events
- Good early season growth
- Initial counts show another very fruitful season with high bunch numbers



Machinery Upgrades

- Replaced the old Eole sprayer with new recycling 3 row shrouded sprayer
- Working well giving more coverage of the vines and extending spray windows
- Recovery rates depend on canopy size but are currently averaging 30%, reducing chemical costs

New Herbicide Unit

- Replaced old unit with larger improved model
- Has shrouds to enable spraying in windier conditions
- Provides better undervine weed control, reducing competition and stress on vines
