












FROST


- Helicopters on site 9 times
- Flown 7 times
- Several close calls-not forecasted with no helicopters on site
- Have been down to 2 degrees twice this week
- No damage except in a few low lying areas of the vineyard, so no crop loss.
- Damage can affect vines for 2 years
- Late season frosts can cause severe damage and destroy the efforts of early season protection


















Syrah

- Originated from the Rhone in France
- Called Shiraz in Australia/ South Africa
- Naturally vigorous
- Large tall bunches (size contained on low vigour sites)
- Sensitive to nutritional changes
- Can be cropped at a wide range of levels
- Range of wine styles are produced
- Harvest late in season to achieve full flavours
- Common as single varietal wine
